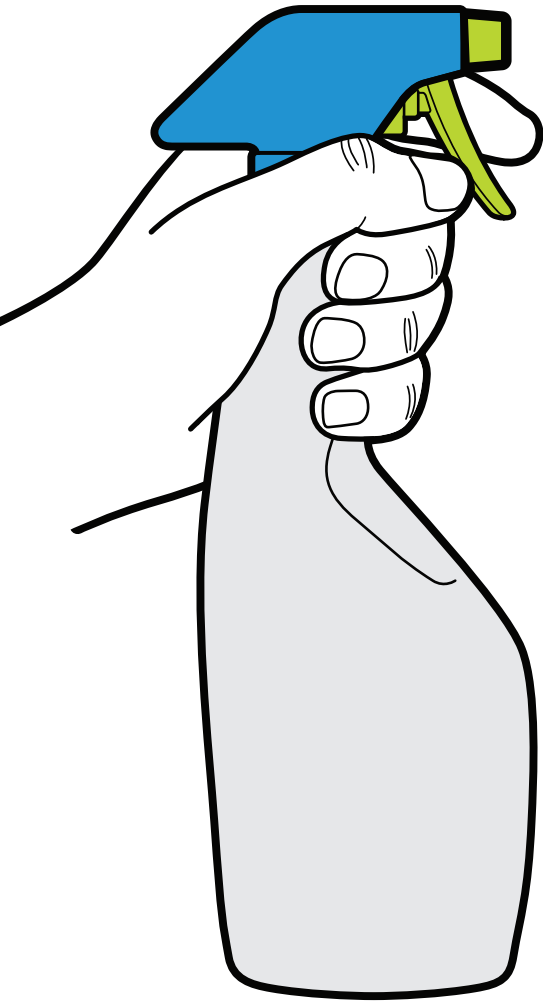

...you can clean and disinfect your PolySorb panels

In the post-COVID environment it is still important to properly clean and disinfect your surfaces, public spaces and offices. Fortunately, our PolySorb products are made out of recycled plastics - so they are very easy to sanitize!



“EASY!”

...follow these simple steps to disinfect your panels

1. Choose one of the recommended disinfectants.*
2. Lightly spray the surface of the panel with a hand spray bottle.
3. Allow the panels to fully air dry.

* For disinfection, common household EPA-registered solutions should be highly effective.

* Please refer to the EPA-approved product list that are effective against the viruses.

* A diluted solution of household bleach (at least 1000 ppm sodium hypochlorite) can be sprayed. Prepare a bleach solution by combining 5 tablespoons bleach per gallon of water. Bleach solutions will remain effective for a time period of up to 24 hours.

...cleaning and maintenance

- Use a micro fiber cloth or tacky lint roller to remove all loose dirt and dust and/or vacuum lightly with clean soft brush attachment.
- If still dirty, use a moist towel or a rubber sponge. You can blot with a mild detergent for more stubborn stains, or use a non abrasive upholstery cleaner.
- Be sure to test in a small unnoticeable area first to make sure there are no adverse reactions to your solutions.
- Blot dry with a clean absorbent cloth.
- Heavily damaged panels should be replaced.
